- The city of Brownsville, TX has implemented a new law, banning businesses from giving out plastic bags.
- Prepare now to make sure your business is covered.



"Businesses are prohibited from providing plastic shopping bags as of January 1, 2011 excepting only plastic shopping bags specifically provided to the customer at the point of sale for the purpose of transporting meat, fish, and poultry products. Businesses may instead provide only recyclable paper bags, reusable bags or biodegradable bags as checkout bags to their customers with or without charge."
